Admission Priority Policy

Those students who apply to Macon East Academy may be accepted, on a space available basis, according to the following priorities:

- Students with a 2.5 GPA for the past school year
- Students with a 2.49-2.0 GPA for the past school year may be accepted on a conditional basis. To continue enrollment, that student must maintain at least a 2.0 GPA at Macon East Academy at the conclusion of the school year.
- Standardized test scores at or above grade level, when applicable
- No major disciplinary actions reported from previous school
- Good attendance records at previous school
- Positive teacher recommendations
- Personal interview: Student and family advance the mission and share the philosophy of Macon East Academy

The Admissions Committee will review each application in full and make a determination on acceptance on a case by case basis
