

Dear Macon East Parents,

The safety of our students while attending school is one of our top priorities. In order to be sure that your student is well taken care of in the case of an accident on campus, all students will receive coverage from National Security's Group Accident Policy. This primary policy includes "School Day Coverage" for all students while attending regular school sessions, while traveling directly to and from your home premises and the school for school sessions and school sponsored activities within one hour of dismissal, and while taking part in a school sponsored activity (this does not include coverage in interscholastic football for grades 7-12). This plan is designed to supplement your already existing insurance plan. You decide how to use the benefits received under the plan; this may include using your plan benefits to meet a deductible or copayment.

Along with the "School Day Coverage," you may also want to consider enrolling your student in the "24-Hour Accident Coverage." This plan provides benefits 24 hours a day, 7 days a week during the school year and summer (up until midnight the day before school begins for the next school year). Students are covered in non-school related activities under this plan. Limitations and exclusions are listed on the back of the **National Insurance Company brochure which is available in both lower and upper school offices**. The cost for this policy is \$28 per student.

The brochure includes more information about "School Day Coverage" and "24-Hour Accident Coverage." The brochure also outlines the policy benefits and the policy limitations and exclusions. If you choose to enroll your student in the "24-Hour Accident Coverage" plan, please complete the form below and return it with your payment of \$28 per student to the upper or lower school office.
