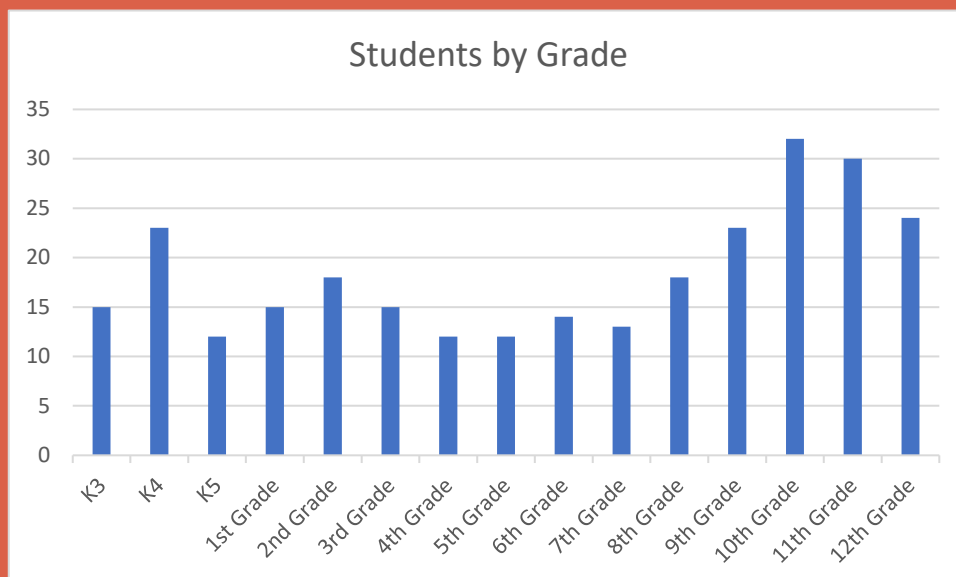

**PRE-K AND KINDERGARTEN:** Our Pre-K and Kindergarten programs are designed to foster the growth of the whole child. Self-contained classrooms provide the perfect start to a lifetime of learning. Each child benefits from the individual attention provided by our experienced full-time early childhood teachers. Kindergarten students focus on reading, math, and essential readiness skills. They use iPads for additional enrichment activities. K3 and K4 students experience a nurturing fun-filled day of developmentally appropriate activities.

The K3-Kindergarten experience at Macon East Academy is an exciting time in the life of a child. As children learn to navigate their world during these formative years, our program seeks to provide a safe learning environment which emphasizes the cognitive, social, emotional, and physical growth of each child. The rich and engaging curriculum provides learning opportunities and activities for students to become independent, self-confident learners.

**LOWER SCHOOL:** In the elementary portion of the Lower School, students (Grade 1-6) develop a solid foundation in Language Arts, Mathematics, Reading, Science, and Social Studies. Instruction in Art, Music, Physical Education, Spanish, and Technology, as well as individual and class projects further motivate and stimulate the students. The curriculum incorporates creative activities including musical performances, a series of developmentally appropriate activities, blending skill-building, motor development, problem solving, and reasoning skills. Macon East provides a positive and engaging learning environment for our elementary students. Lower school classes have enrichment in the areas of computer, art, library, music, and Spanish. Elementary students also have daily physical education classes.

We believe in preparing students for success in a challenging and enriching educational experience from their first day on campus. Small class sizes allow for a family atmosphere and close relationships between the students and faculty.
